80% of Iran's Medical Staff Vaccinated against Coronavirus

Iran has vaccinated nearly 80% of the health workers engaged in the COVID-19 activities, Deputy Health Minister Maryam Hazrati said. "Approximately 80 percent of the health staff that have been treating COVID-19 patients have so far been vaccinated," Hazarti said on Wednesday.

She added that Iran is busy vaccinating citizens with the priority of the health workers and doctors working at the intensive care units and those dealing with the COVID-19 patients. The official noted that the vaccination of other citizens, particularly the high-risk groups, will be done gradually based on the health ministry's codes.

Iran's progress in aerospace industry in 1399, Iranian calendar year

Iran is one of the countries that has the capability to build both satellites and satellite carriers. It was in early May of last year that, Noor, Iran's first multipurpose satellite was launched. Noor was launched by the satellite carrier called Ghasedak in three stages, which the superpowers have the capability to build only. Pars 1 satellite was delivered to the country's space organization after successful tests. Using Zul-Jannah satellite with solid fuel was another important achievement in the space field of the country. Construction of Simorgh and Sarir satellites has continued this year and is progressing rapidly. A biospace capsule was also unveiled, which is a prelude to sending the astronaut to 130 kilometers of Earth. Last year, the country's space data center was opened to provide satellite data to enthusiasts in this field.

How much electricity do Iran's power plants generate?

According to the latest published statistics, the total capacity of the installed power plants in the country last year compared to the previous year, increased by 2.2 percent to 85 thousand and 313 MW.

In the energy sector, last year, with a growth of 5.1 percent compared to 1398, Iranian calendar year, reached 343 billion kilowatt hours, of which 337 billion kilowatt hours were related to the production of power plants of the Ministry of Energy, the private sector and the rest belonged to big industries.


vessels docked at Bandar Abbas to further strengthen bilateral and friendly relations with Iran.
