Spokesman for Iran National Headquarters of Administrating coronavirus:

We hope that in July, 2 domestically produced vaccines will be among the countries vaccine capacity.

So far, 420,000 doses of vaccine have been imported from Russia, 650,000 doses from China, 700,000 doses from South Korea and 125,000 doses from India.

Production manager of "Iran Barakat vaccine":

As we promised, during this spring we will increase the semi-industrial production capacity of the vaccine to 3 million doses per month.

In addition to producing 3 million doses of vaccine in the semi-industrial production line, the industrial line with a capacity of 12 to 15 million doses per month will be operational from the summer this year and the production of this line will be added to this capacity.

Iran Health Minister: We are not behind the schedule in vaccination

Minister of Health:

So far, Taiwan has received 27,000 doses, Vietnam 58,000 doses, South Korea 61,000 doses, Japan 642,000 doses, Oman 193,000 doses, Egypt 165,000 doses and Iraq 153,000 doses.

Iran has injected about 500,000 doses and will reach about 1.3 million by next week, but some say we are behind schedule. The United States and Britain have not delivered vaccines to Canada, which has bought five times as much as it needs.

Iran says it has enriched uranium with 60% purity

Iran started enriching uranium up to 60% purity on Friday after an attack targeted its Natanz nuclear plant, Tehran's parliament speaker said.

Mohammad Bagher Qalibaf tweeted: "I am proud to announce that at 00:40 last night, and on the night of the pilgrimage of Sayyid al-Shuhada, young and pious Iranian scientists were able to obtain a product of 60% enriched uranium."

He added: "Congratulations to the brave people of Islamic Iran on this success."

The former head of the Atomic Energy Organization of Iran and the current head of the Energy Commission of the Islamic Consultative Assembly said that the country had the capability to produce 60% enriched uranium for ocean propulsion and submarines ten years ago.

Iran's actions in combating the global drug problem during 2020


Secretary General of the Anti-Narcotics Headquarters of Iran:

Iran's Historical Places: Chehel Sotoun



Shazdeh Considered to be one of the urban indicators of Isfahan, Chehel Sotoun Palace is located next to Naqsh-e Jahan Square and in the neighborhood of Chahar Bagh. This garden along with its central glorious mansion are among the memories of Safavid rule in Isfahan which was designed by Sheikh Bahahei after selecting Isfahan as the state capital. Being considered as a Persian garden, it includes a mansion or garden in the center which was established in time of Shah Abbas I in form of a pavilion and it was developed in the time of Shah Abbas II and then called Chehel Sotoun. It was internationally inscribed by UNESCO as one of the characterized Persian gardens.
