Mapna's hydrogen gas turbine to make debut

Mapna, the engineering and energy giant, has manufactured hydrogen-fuelled gas turbines that consume less gas to generate electricity and instead of hazardous emissions discharge water, the managing director said. CEO Abbas Aliabadi told reporters Thursday the MGT-75 turbine will be unveiled soon and considerably boost production from existing infrastructure without the need for new and costly power plants.

"MGT-75 is an industrial accomplishment and one of the best-in-class turbines in the world. The new generation MGT-70 turbines allow expansion of power production without spending massive amounts on new units," Aliabadi said. Adding hydrogen to natural gas is a major step toward decarbonize energy production as its combustion process emits less greenhouse gases including CO2. It also produces more energy.

The tragic incident of fire at Islam Qala customs in Herat, Afghanistan, despite great financial losses and suffering for people, once again showed the long-standing unity and solidarity between Iran and Afghanistan. In the first hours after the fire started at Islam Qala customs, the Iranian media followed it quickly, resulting in the Iranian government prompt reaction to help the neighbouring country and Afghan businessmen operating in the economic zone.

"If we had not had the help of the fire department of Iran's Khorasan Razavi province, it would not have been impossible for the Herat firefighters to contain the uncontrollable flames. NATO did not respond to the Afghanistan's request did not respond to the firefighting helicopters," Arianpour TV reported.

"What is important is that the Iranians rushed to help, and other foreign forces refused to send a firefighting helicopter," Ariana News stated.

The Afghan media added that the reason for the refusal of NATO forces was not yet clear. But one thing became clear in this incident: neighbours are together on good and bad days, while strangers are useless on bad days.

Iran says assesses EU invitation to meet with U.S.

Abbas Araqchi, the Iranian deputy foreign minister, said late on Saturday that Iran is studying a European Union proposal for an informal meeting between current members of Tehran's 2015 nuclear deal and the United States, but has yet to respond to it.

Araqchi said EU foreign policy chief Josep Borrell has expressed his readiness to invite the current parties to the JCPOA, namely the P4+1 and Iran, to attend an unofficial meeting to develop the future roadmap of the deal.

Speaking at a televised program, Araqchi said, "We are studying Josep Borrell's proposal to hold an informal meeting of the 4+1 (nuclear deal members) with the United States and Iran, and we are consulting with our partners, including Russia and China, and we will respond to this proposal in the future."

"However, we believe a U.S. return to the nuclear accord does not require a meeting, and the only way for it is to lift the sanctions," Araqchi added.

Iran, IAEA reach 'temporary bilateral technical understanding'

Iran and the International Atomic Energy Agency (IAEA) have reached a "temporary bilateral technical understanding" during the visit of the IAEA chief to Tehran, according to a joint statement.

The joint statement, which was released by the IAEA following its director-general's trip to Tehran on Sunday, declares that Iran will stop its voluntary implementation of the Additional Protocol to the Non-Proliferation Treaty (NPT) and will deny IAEA inspectors access to its nuclear facilities beyond the Safeguards Agreement as of February 23, 2021 for three months.
