Iran plans to mass produce COVID-19 vaccine by late spring

The director of the vaccine production research group of The Execution of Imam Khomeini's Order (EIKO) and the head of Iran Covid-19 vaccine production team said that the industrial production site is currently being prepared, saying "our forecast is that the site will be launched in late spring and the production capacity will be more than 10 million doses per month."

The director of clinical trials at Tehran University of Medical Sciences also said that phases two and three of the clinical studies of Iran Barakat vaccine will be combined. Phases two and three include a population of about 20,000; A subset of these volunteers, numbering about 400, form the second phase of the study.

Second Iranian COVID-19 vaccine enters clinical trial

Iran started the human trial of its second coronavirus vaccine, Razi Cov Pars, by injecting it into two volunteers during a ceremony on Sunday.

The vaccine is both injectable and intranasal based on recombinant COVID-19 proteins, Mohammad Hassan Fallah, deputy head of Razi Vaccine and Serum Research Institute, said.

Through the first phase of the human trial, 133 people will receive the vaccine, 13 of whom are injected in the first group and the rest in four groups consisting of thirty members, he noted.

After 23 days, phase one of vaccination should be completed.

"The second dose of the vaccine will be injected to the volunteers 21 days later and the third dose will be inhaled 51 days later," he explained.

He went on to say that the vaccine was produced according to the instructions of the World Health Organization, adding, Razi Institute started making vaccines in March 2020 and used the recombinant protein-based method, which is one of the safest vaccines.

Mice cannot catch coronavirus; but new Iranian gene-edited mice can

Iran's Royan Institute, which specializes in biomedical and stem cell research, has created transgenic mice with a human receptor on their cells. The receptor, called hACE2, is the one that the coronavirus uses to make its way into human cells. That means the genetically-modified mice can now catch the virus.

Royan Institute is currently developing its own COVID vaccine. The preclinical stages will involve testing the vaccine on the genetically modified mice. Royan's vaccine is one of the eight jabs Iran is developing. Two of them have made their way to the human trial phase, so far.

Iran oil output doubles in 5 years: Minister

Iranian Oil Minister Bijan Zangeneh said the country's petrol production capacity had more than doubled since 2013. Addressing the opening ceremony of Phase III of Bandar Abbas Gas Condensate Refinery (also called the Persian Gulf Star Refinery) on Monday, the Oil Minister Bijan Zangeneh said Iran's petrol production capacity currently stood at 101 million liters per day from 50 ml/d back in 2013.

He said 76 ml/d of Euro-4 and 5 petrol was produced in the country, adding inauguration of the first three phases of the refinery had realized a major leap in the country's petrol production capacity.

Iran not to receive passengers from 32 countries: Official

Civil aviation authority spokesman Mohammad Hassan Zibakhsh on Sunday said that Iran has banned flights from Iran to 32 countries and vice versa to tackle the coronavirus outbreak.

Pointing to the decrees of the National Headquarters for the Management of COVID-19 and to prevent the spread of the coronavirus in the country, Zibakhsh said that the admission of passengers from high-risk countries to Iran was banned.

He stressed that all Iranian and foreign nationals who intend to travel to Iran are required to provide a negative molecular test certificate (RT-PCR) in terms of COVID-19 with a validity

period of up to 96 hours from laboratories approved by the Ministry of Health of the country of origin in English or approved by the consulate before boarding the plane at the airport of origin. http://tn.ai/2461434

Mackenzie reveals information regarding bombing of Al Assad in Iraq in retaliation for the assassination of Sardar Soleimani.

CBS television broadcast a report on the Iranian missile attack on the US base of Al Assad in Iraq after the assassination of Major General Soleimani and recounted a new version of the story from the survivors of the attack.

"When the US intelligence service learned that Iran was preparing for a missile strike, we had enough time to evacuate the base," said Frank Mackenzie, commander of US Central Command (Centcom). "There were soldiers and 50 fighters. If we had not evacuated, I think we would have lost 20-30 fighters and 100 to 150 troops."

In another part of the documentary, Mackenzie acknowledges that "he has never seen or experienced such an attack before." "Their (Iran's) missiles are accurate and hit wherever they want."

More than a year after the attack, an American major named Alan Johnson still has a headache, ringing in his ears, and nightmares. He considers his survival a "good luck".
