Iranian Norouz Traditions: Haft Seen

Nowruz is the national New Year festivity celebrated in Iran and Afghanistan. In some other countries, such as Tajikistan, Russia, Kyrgyzstan, Kazakhstan, Syria, Iraq, Georgia, Azerbaijan, Albania, China, Turkey, Turkmenistan, India, Pakistan and Uzbekistan, this festivity is celebrated by the people.

Nowruz is a springtime celebration whose activities symbolize rebirth and the link between humans and nature. The Iranian poet Saadi (1210-1291) wrote: "Awaken, the morning Nowruz breeze is showering the garden with flowers."

While the two-week celebrations center on seeing relatives, picnicking, travelling, and eating traditional food, Nowruz itself - which is Farsi for New Day - is steeped in ancient myths and fiction, as well as traditions and symbols.

Iranians mark Nowruz by setting the Haft Seen, a table with seven items starting with the Persian /s/ sound.

The items usually include Sabzeh (freshly grown greens), Samanu (a sweet pudding made from germinated wheat), Senjed (the dried fruit of the oleaster tree), Seeb (apple), Seer (garlic), Somagh (sumac) and Serkeh (vinegar).

People also put the holy Qur'an next to the main Haft Seen items in hopes of being blessed by God in the year ahead.

The mirror (symbolizing cleanliness and honesty), a bowl of water with goldfish, decorated eggs (symbolizing fertility) sometimes one for each member of the family, candles (enlightenment and sunrise), coins (representing wealth), dried nuts and fruits and Sonbol (hyacinth) are also among the items Iranians include in their Haft Seen.

Iranian professor at Canadian university develops self-driving bus

A research team led by Amir Khajeapour, an Iranian professor of mechanical and mechatronics engineering, has spent over four years creating the autonomous bus project called the "WATonoBUS." According to the university, the project has cost well over \$1 million and the vehicle is now in its final testing to ensure it can handle winter weather.

School officials said the bus could be operating on Ring Road at the school by the time students return to campus for in-person classes once COVID-19 restrictions ease. "We're hoping that when students come back to campus, whether that is in September or earlier, this shuttle bus will be ready to provide a needed service," Khajepour said in a news release. "Students will be able to take the LRT train to campus, then take our bus to any part of campus."
